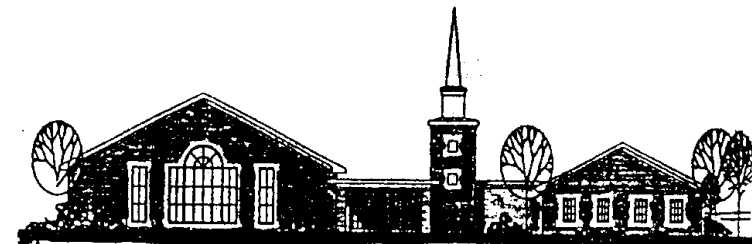
FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH
