What did believers do after Jesus left them and before Pentecost?

Tried to “keep their eyes on Jesus.” (1:10; Heb. 12:2)

Waited for Jesus’ return. (1:11; Matt. 16:27)

Stayed together. (1:12-13; 2:42)

Constantly joined together in prayer. (1:14; 2:42)

Relied on Scripture to put their lives in perspective. (1:16-20)

Required that new leaders know Jesus well. (1:21-26; 1 Tim. 3:6)

Understood that witnessing was telling their personal story about Jesus. (1:22; 1 John 1:1)

Selected leaders by casting lots. (1:26)

What difference did the Spirit make for them?

Their witnessing was bold. (2:4; 4:8, 31; 9:17; 13:9)

Their witnessing was effective. (2:11)

Besides witnessing, what does a life full of the Spirit do in the life of the believer/church?

Makes a person useful for service in the body. (6:35; 1 Cor. 12:7)

Gives a person confidence in times of trouble. (7:55)

Gives direction. (8:29, 39; 10:19; 11:12; 16:6-7; 20:22; Gal. 5:18)

Gives the church encouragement/comfort. (9:31; Phil. 2:1)

Confirms that a person is a believer. (10:44-45; 19:6; Rom. 8:16)

Helps the church select leaders. (13:12; 20:28; Eph. 4:11-13)

Fills with joy. (13:52; Rom. 14:17)
