The new way that you were taught about at first: (4:20-24)

- 4:20-22 – Put off the old self.
- 4:23 – Be made new in your minds.
- 4:24 – Put on the new self, righteous & holy.

What you must put off and what you must put on: (4:25-5:20)

- 4:25 – Lies/truth
- 4:26-27 – Inappropriate anger/self-control
- 4:28 – Stealing/Honest work & generosity
- 4:29 – Foul or abusive language/helpful words
- 4:30-5:2 – Bitterness & meanness/kindness & forgiveness
- 5:3-7 – Immorality, impurity & greed/thanksgiving
- 5:8-14 – Deeds of darkness/deeds of light
- 5:15-16 – Wasteful/make the most of every opportunity
- 5:17-20 – Controlled by wine/controlled by the Spirit


