How does Jesus want to be known? (2:8)

He is the First and the Last. (Isa. 44:6; 48:12)
He is the one who died and came to life again.
How you should live is based on who Jesus is.

What does Jesus know about them and their enemies? (2:9)

Jesus knows the suffering and poverty of his people.
Their enemies are liars like their "father." (John 8:44)
Even though you are poor, you are rich. (James 2:5)

They will be tested, but should persevere. (2:10)

The devil will test you. (Matt. 4:1; Job 1)
