Finding Your Story in God's Story

They were transformed as they encountered Jesus in the Scriptures. (v. 32; Romans 12:2)

You will only be transformed on the inside if you allow the deeper parts of you to interact with the Word of God.

How can you encounter Jesus in the Scriptures?

1. Be in the Word and let the Word be in you. (e.g. Isa. 43:1-3)
2. Practice *lectio divina*: be silent, read, meditate, respond, rest.
3. Is there someone in the Bible that you identify with? What did Jesus/God want to change in them? What did Jesus/God do? What did He offer to them? How did they respond? How would you respond?
