*How does Jesus want to be known?*

He is holy and true. (3:7; 6:9-11; 19:11; Mark 1:24)  
He holds the key of David. (3:7; Isa. 22:22; Matt. 16:19)

*What does Jesus say about the church?*

They have a little strength. (3:8)  
They have kept Jesus' word and not denied his name. (3:8, 10)

*What is Jesus going to do?*

He is giving them an open door. (3:8; Acts 14:27)  
The false Jews will fall at their feet and confess that Jesus loves the church. (3:9; Rom. 8:37-39)  
He will keep them from the hour of trial. (3:10; Dan. 12:2; Mark 13:14)  
He is coming soon. (3:11; James 5:8)

*What are they supposed to do?*

Hold on, so that no one will take their crown. (3:11)

*What will he do for the victorious?*

He will make them a pillar in God's temple. (3:12; Gal. 2:9)  
They will never leave it. (3:12)  
He will write holy names on them. (3:12; 14:1; 22:4)
