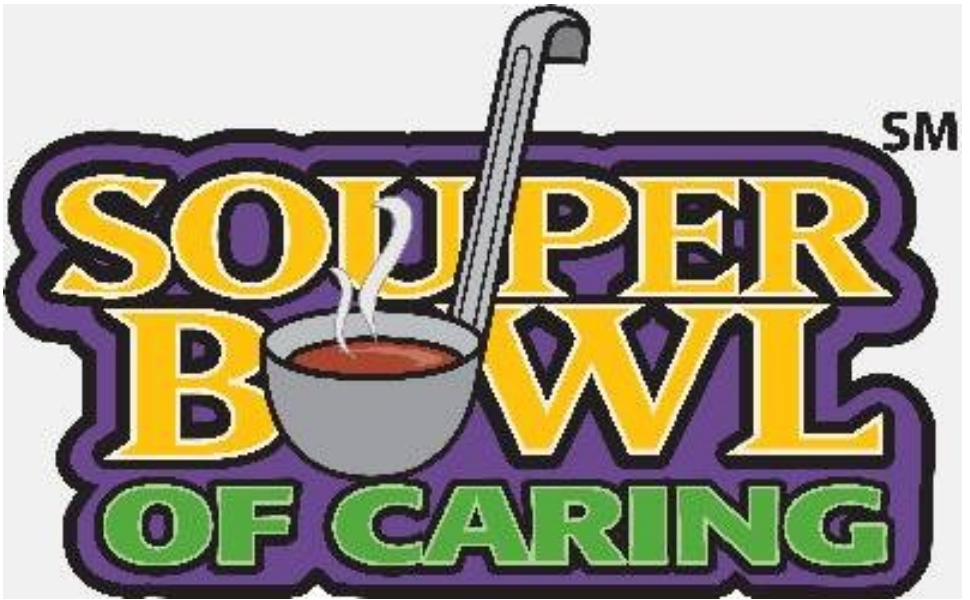

1 John 2:17-27

February 2, 2020

It is the last hour...

(2:17-18)

What is the last hour? (Rev. 1:3)

How do we know it is here?

There are enemies of Christ all around you.

(2:18, 22; 4:3; 2 John 1:7)

They are *against* and *instead* of Christ.

There will be one Anti-Christ. (Dan. 7:25; 8:25; 11:36; 2 Thess. 2:4;

Rev. 13:5-6)

But you are anointed.

(2:20-27)

You have a permanent anointing. (2:20, 27)

It is from God. (2:20, 27; Luke 4:18; 2 Cor. 1:21-22)

It is related to knowing the truth and not lies. (2:20, 27)

It is related to perseverance of salvation. (2:24, 27)

The anointing is real, not counterfeit. (2:27)

If you have the anointing, do you need to worry about the antichrists?
