'You are here' with volunteers rebuilding flood-ravaged Baton Rouge

"I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink..."

Matthew 25:35



In August 2016, unprecedented rainfall caused flooding that affected more than 55,000 homes in the Baton Rouge, LA area. American Baptist Home Mission Societies volunteers have traveled to the area several times to help rebuild. These dedicated volunteer restoration efforts were fueled by muscle, by commitment, and by **One Great Hour of Sharing** (OGHS) funds.

"Our initial view of Baton Rouge was debris piled on the curb and FEMA trailers for temporary housing," said Jack Cobb, American Baptist Men's national disaster-relief coordinator. "Installation of sheetrock was our priority, with some electrical and plumbing completed." Volunteers gutted the home of Kenneth Chandler, pastor of Shady Grove First Missionary Baptist Church. His home had suffered up to 1 foot of water, while the church accumulated 22 inches of water throughout its sanctuary and Family Life Center. In addition, 39 parishioners' homes were impacted by the flood.

"I'm grateful for all of the help, for all of the prayers, for everything that's being rendered to assist all of us in this region," Chandler said.

Volunteers found themselves blessed too. "The greatest one [blessing] is the opportunity to meet the people who've been severely impacted by the event and to listen to their stories. Only then does the real tragedy become apparent in a personal way," said Joyce McVicker, a volunteer from The Baptist Temple, Fairmont, W.Va. "While we are here to meet the needs of the local folks, others are serving us by providing lodging, food, and other kinds of support. While we come expecting to be the servants, we find ourselves being served!"
