**Music Notes:** Today's Offertory, "A Quiet Place", was written by Ralph Carmichael, born May 28, 1927, the son of a Pentecostal minister. He is a composer and arranger of both secular pop music and contemporary Christian music, and is regarded as one of the pioneers of the latter genre. While a student at Southern California Bible College, he started a campus men's quartet, ensembles and mixed groups of all kinds, blending jazz and classical music techniques with gospel songs and hymns. His musical experiments proved instantly controversial, and his bands were unwelcome at many churches because the music was considered too worldly.

Despite early controversy, Carmichael went on to realize success in both secular and sacred music fields. On the sacred side, where he was most prolific, he composed the musical scores for twenty films produced by the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association; he provided the backing arrangements for a number of RCA albums by Gospel singer George Beverly Shea; he collaborated with Kurt Kaiser on *Tell It Like It Is*, a Christian folk musical; one of Carmichael's contemporary hymns, "Reach Out to Jesus", was recorded by Elvis Presley, on his 1972 Grammy Award-winning album of sacred songs.

On the secular side he composed and arranged music for various television shows including *I Love Lucy*, *Bonanza*, *My Mother the Car*, *The Roy Rogers and Dale Evans Show*, and Bing Crosby's TV Christmas special; he wrote arrangements for Rosemary Clooney, Ella Fitzgerald, Bing Crosby, Stan Kenton, Jack Jones, Peggy Lee, Julie London, Al Martino and Roger Williams. In the late 1950s he began working

with Nat King Cole and became Cole's most regularly utilized arranger from then until the singer's death in early 1965.

"A Quiet Place" was written in 1967 and, in typical Carmichael style, incorporates jazz harmonies. The text is as follows:

There is a quiet place,  
Far from the rapid pace  
Where God can soothe my troubled mind.  
Sheltered by tree and flow'r,  
There in my quiet hour  
With Him my cares are left behind.  
Whether a garden small,  
Or on a mountain tall,  
New strength and courage there I find;  
Then from this quiet place  
I go prepared to face a new day  
With love for all mankind.
